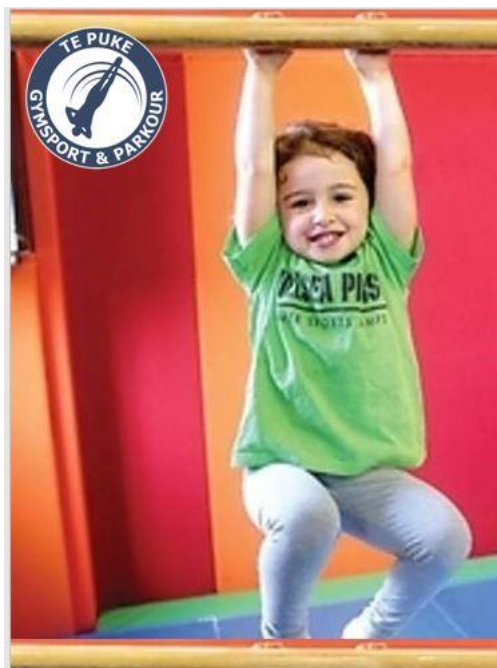
Working Bee – 15th September 9am – 12pm
